We produce copper and other metals needed for everyday products and essential for applications to support the energy transition toward a more sustainable future.


CREATING VALUE WITH PURPOSE

In December 2022, we announced our commitment to achieve net zero GHG emissions by 2050. Hudbay should be an active player in the decarbonization of the planet. We want to run safe operations, working in a collaborative, respectful and mutually beneficial manner with the communities near our mines.
