Among the policies and programs the group will consider are: ITAR, EAR, NAFTA, CTPAT, Customs and Border Protection and Census regulations.

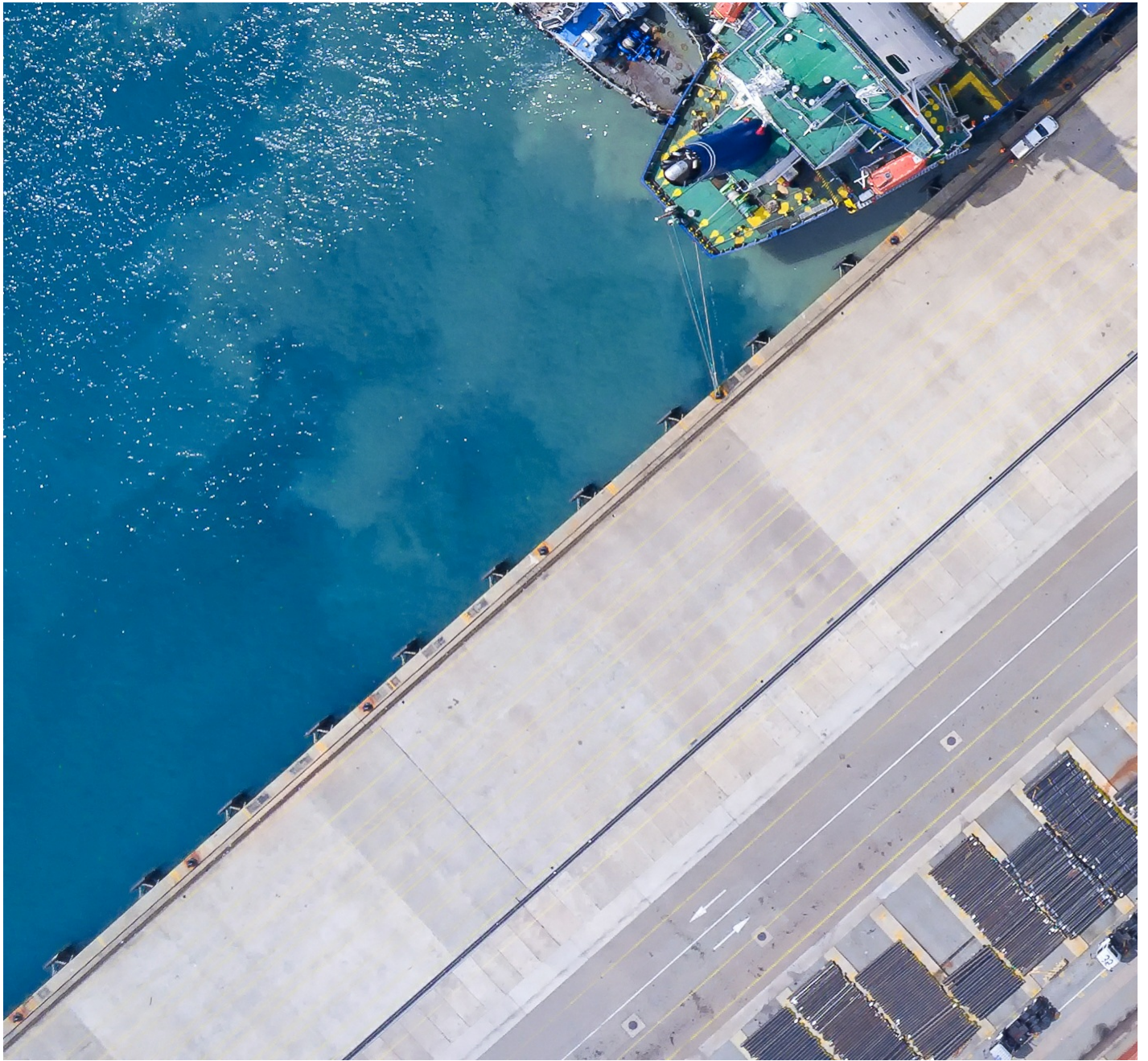
