Donaldson Company, Inc. (NYSE: DCI) announced today that Joseph E. Lehman, Vice President, Global Operations, will retire on August 1, 2015. Lehman, 60, joined Donaldson in 1984 as a Financial Analyst and then held a number of key management roles in Finance, Operations, Information Technology and business unit management. He was promoted to Vice President, Global Operations in 2010. Lehman was also Vice President, Global Engine Aftermarket from 2007 to 2009.
