MSG Networks Announces March 2 as Official Launch for Live Streaming of Its Local NHL Telecasts on MSG GO

MSG GO is currently available at no charge to subscribers of participating providers (currently Optimum, Comcast Xfinity and Service Electric Broadband Cable) who receive MSG Networks as part of their pay television subscription. Subscribers will have access to the same games they receive on MSG Networks in their home¹. Subscribers with a supported smartphone or tablet can download the free MSG GO app by visiting the App Store or the Google Play store. On computers, customers may visit MSGGo.com.
