 ▶ The Class A Common Stock distribution of \$0.540 per share declared on October 28, 2020 by The Blackstone Group Inc.  
 ("Company") will be paid on November 16, 2020. The date of record is at the close of business on November 9, 2020.

**15** Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ The Company currently estimates that the Class A Common Stock shareholder's tax basis will reduce by \$0.306 per share as a result of the above distributions.

**16** Describe the calculation of the change in basis and the data that supports the calculation, such as the market values of securities and the valuation dates ▶ Pursuant to Internal Revenue Code Sections 301(c) and 316(c), the distributions are treated as taxable dividend to the extent of the Company's current and accumulated earnings and profits. Distributions in excess of the Company's current and accumulated earnings and profits are treated as nontaxable return of capital to the extent of the stockholder's tax basis. Any distributions in excess of the stockholder's basis will be treated as capital gains for U.S. tax purposes. The taxability of the Company's distributions and the determination of the character of the distributions are based on the most current and accurate estimated earnings and profits information for the period ended December 31, 2020 available at the time this Form is published. The calculation of earnings and profits differs from income calculated in accordance with GAAP and non-GAAP metrics used in segment reporting (fee related earnings & realized income) since it is based on taxable income which includes certain non-cash deduction, among other book to tax differences in income and expenses.
