



Knicks Announce \$1 Million Raised for Garden of Dreams Foundation Through Fundraiser for Two Celebrity Row Seats

The \$1 Million Dollar Donation is the Single Largest Donation in the History of the Garden of Dreams Foundation

NEW YORK--(BUSINESS WIRE)-- Madison Square Garden Sports Corp. ("MSG Sports") announced today that \$1 million has been raised for the Garden of Dreams Foundation through the Knicks fundraiser for two Celebrity Row seats at Game 3 of the NBA Finals Monday at The Garden. Leading global law firm Gibson, Dunn and Crutcher LLP ("Gibson Dunn") and preeminent private-equity firm Veritas Capital split the winning bid, totaling \$1 million. The donation is the single largest donation in the history of the foundation and proceeds from the fundraiser will go directly to the Garden of Dreams Foundation.

The Garden of Dreams Foundation is a non-profit organization that works with the MSG Family of Companies – MSG Entertainment, MSG Sports and Sphere Entertainment – to positively impact the lives of children facing obstacles.
