

The Madison Square Garden Company Donates \$500K and Hosts Telethon to Benefit Hurricane Sandy Relief Efforts

Recipient Organizations are the Mayor's Fund to Advance New York City and American Red Cross

NEW YORK, Nov. 2, 2012 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- The Madison Square Garden Company (Nasdaq:MSG) will donate \$500,000 and host a telethon on MSG Network to support the relief and rebuilding efforts for those affected by Hurricane Sandy.
